About the Role - Mō te tūnga

The Registered Nurse will support whānau through clinical assessment, intervention, care planning and education in a community clinic setting; and provide outreach nursing. Our mahi is a team effort and the RN works in conjunction with the Nurse Practitioner to address the individual needs of whānau. About you – He kōrero mōu

The ideal candidate will have the following:

- Registered Nurse with current NCNZ practicing certificate, preferably with vaccinator and cervical screening qualifications

- Tikanga Māori and Te Reo Māori skills
- Full NZ drivers license

This is a 37.5 hour/week role based in Invercargill. You will be supported to have clinical supervision and training and development opportunities.
