The Nurse Practitioner/Mātanga Tapuhi is responsible for providing clinical expertise in a Te Kakano community setting. You must be comfortable utilising Māori models of care and you value health and social service collaboration to best meet the needs of the patient and their whanau.

About you – He kōrero mōu

The ideal candidate will have the following:

- Registered Nurse Practitioner with a current NCNZ practicing certificate
- Be an authorised prescriber and smear taker, and preferably have experience or a qualification in health education
- Strong links and experience with Southern Māori communities and able to connect through whakawhanaungatanga
- Tikanga Māori and Te Reo Māori skills
- Confidence to work independently and as a team member
- Able to demonstrate a high level of personal integrity
- Full NZ drivers license

You will be supported with clinical supervision and access to training and development opportunities. To provide clinics in community settings across Otago you will be provided with a mobile phone, laptop and access to a fleet vehicle.
