Awarua Whānau Services delivers a kaupapa Māori service that provides for whānau wellbeing by supporting their social and health education needs.

### **About the Role - Mō te tūnga**

The Rangatahi Mentor will walk alongside rangatahi providing individual mentoring. You will help with events; and facilitate group and school holiday programmes allowing youth to maximise their potential and thrive. The focus is on positive youth development with their whānau and the wider Motupōhue community. This is a fixed term position until 30 June 2024, working 20 hours per week.

### **About you – He kōrero mōu**

You will be a positive role model, experienced working with youth and committed to providing guidance and encouraging rangatahi to be confident, responsible individuals. You will have great communication skills, good local networks, and experience building relationships. A full NZ drivers license is essential and helpful if you were comfortable with matauranga māori concepts and practices.
